

COURSE - START




The start is on Oscarsbron and officials will support and guide the skiers to the correct starting positions

Roller skis are provided by Alliansloppet/Rullskidcenter, Swenor Alutech with wheel type 3, for all athletes in the Alliansloppet Elit classes

The skis shall be picked up by each competitor on the way to the start

Be in time, min 10 minutes before start!



























COURSE - LAPPING VS. FINISH




NO corridors during the Elit race this year

COURSE - UNIQUE FINISH LAP 3




New unique course before the finish for the front group of 'Men Elit 48 km' and 'Women Elit 48 km', now "only" the last ~1.3 km of the final lap

On the road instead of the parallel bicycle road from a opening in the road/bicycle divider close to the intersection Albertsvägen / Vänersborgsvägen

The road will be closed and cleared from traffic to allow athletes to use the whole road until the finish line

NOTE: It is ONLY during this period the course the road is closed and cleared, else regular traffic rules applies

Officials will guide the competitors and lead vehicles will drive ahead the group for guidance and security























COURSE - UNIQUE FINISH LAP 3





Enter the road via a gap in the road/bicycle divider

~1.3 km to the finish line on the for traffic closed road!

Be safe and mindful of each other, the strongest athlete will have time to sprint to be the winner!!



















POLE SUPPORT CARS

TROLLHÄTTAN ACTION WEEK

As additional service to the coaching zones, one pole car follows the first groups in both 'Alliansloppet Elit' classes

NOTE: Not the first 2 km - nor on the bicycle road on the last 3.5 km

Raise the arm to notify the driver and the skier fall back to the car


Right-poles on left side of the car, left-poles on right side of the car

Men 155 and 160 cm poles, women 150 and 155 cm poles

Not allowed to ski behind the cars!

The pole support cars can't take care of the broken pole!

























BROKEN POLES




Three pole support stations

- Landbergsliden
- Båberg
- Stadium

Replacement poles from the pole support cars and/or the pole stations to be returned in the BIB tent

Broken poles, left at the pole support stations, will be possible to pick up in the BIB tent during the day





















SAFETY INFORMATION



We prioritize sportsmanship and you are a vital part of it! We together choose and act in accordance with a high level of sportsmanship

Use approved helmet and protective glasses, if rain glasses are voluntary, with wheels and other equipment approved by SSF/FIS regulations

Follow Police and Alliansloppet officials directives

During the race, slower riders to the right, you are not allowed to hold someone behind you on purpose

Take care and slow down before sharp corners!

If an accident happens, it's your responsibility to stop and check that the person hurt from the accident is ok or needs help!



















SAFETY INFORMATION, CONTINUED



Ordinary traffic rules apply!

The roads are NOT closed!

Hold to the right!

Roundabouts MUST be passed counterclockwise!

Sidewalks in first hill NOT allowed to be used!

Official lead vehicle from Alliansloppet to clear road!

Support crew are not permitted to follow along the race track during the race!

Speeding support teams between coaching zones are NOT allowed!



















BREAKING THE RACE



If breaking the race you need to inform officials at the Alliansloppsarena

You may not cross the finish line if you break the race!



Cross-Country ski poles must be used with Cross-Country skiing tips must be used. Alternatively poles tips must have safety rigid plastic protections with diameter ≥30 mm. These protections must be placed maximum 45 mm above the metallic tips.

The rule will be implemented from 01st July 2022.
