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

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COURSE – BEFORE START

BIBs and chip distribution in the BIB-tent to the left when entering the arena.

Roller skies (SWENOR Alutech with wheel type 3) are provided by Alliansloppet for all elite participants through;

The skis shall be picked up by each competitor on the way to the start, the skis can be picked up from 10:45

The skis are returned directly after finish

COURSE - START

The start is on Oscarsbron and officials will support and guide the skiers to the correct starting positions.

Gate 1 closest to Landbergsliden

We have 149 separate marked positions. Top 4 skiers with World classic tour BIBs start in front row.

Be in time, min 10 minutes before start!

COURSE - UNIQUE FINISH LAP 3



Unique course before the finish for the front group of 'Men Elit 48 km', on the road all the way from Båberg instead of the parallel bicycle road after NÄL roundabout. The road will be closed and cleared from traffic to allow front men athletes to use the whole road until the finish line.

All the rest of "Men Elite / competition" and "Women Elit" will have same course for all three laps (on parallel bicycle-road).

Officials will guide the competitors and lead vehicles will drive ahead the group for guidance and security

POLE SUPPORT BICYCLE

As additional service to the coaching zones, two pole bicykle follows the first groups in both 'Alliansloppet Elit' classes (Men / Women)

Raise the arm to notify that the skier fall back to the bicycle

Right-poles on left side of the bicycle, left-poles on right side of the bicycle

We provide 145 to 160 cm poles, 2 of each from the beginning

The pole support bicycle can't take care of the broken pole!









BROKEN POLES

Three pole support stations

- Landbergsliden
- Båberg
- Alliansloppet Arena

Replacement poles from the pole support cars and/or the pole stations to be returned in the BIB tent

Broken poles, left at the pole support stations, will be possible to pick up in the BIB tent during the day







SAFETY INFORMATION



We prioritize sportsmanship and you are a vital part of it! We together choose and act in accordance with a high level of sportsmanship

Use approved helmet and protective glasses, if rain glasses are voluntary, with wheels and other equipment approved by SSF/FIS regulations

Follow Police and Alliansloppet officials directives

During the race, slower riders to the right, you are not allowed to hold someone behind you on purpose

Take care and slow down before sharp corners!

If an accident happens, it's your responsibility to stop and check that the person hurt from the accident is ok or needs help!





SAFETY INFORMATION, CONTINUED

Ordinary traffic rules apply!

The roads are NOT closed!

Hold to the right!

Roundabouts MUST be passed counterclockwise!

Sidewalks in first hill NOT allowed to be used!

Official lead motorcykles from Alliansloppet to clear road!

Support crew are not permitted to follow along the race track during the race!

Speeding support teams between coaching zones are NOT allowed!







BREAKING THE RACE

If breaking the race you need to inform officials at the Alliansloppsarena

You may not cross the finish line if you break the race!








PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY

The prize giving ceremony will be held approximately at 16:00 at the main plaza of Trollhättan City. Top 6, as well as WCT









STAGE 4: ALLIANSLOPPET

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




SPRINT

NEW IGR 2022

Pole-tips

SSF wants to make all participants aware that new rules regarding pole tips will come into force during the summer.

Pole-tips must be designed as follows:

"396.2.6 Cross-Country ski poles must be used with Cross-Country skiing tips must be used. Alternatively poles tips must have safety rigid plastic protections with diameter ≥30 mm. These protections must be placed maximum 45 mm above the metallic tips. The rule will be implemented from 01st July 2022."

As these pole tips can currently be difficult to buy, SSF has decided that at competitions arranged in Sweden during the summer of 2022, only check and test measure tips. Athletes who participate in these competitions will not be banned from starting due to incorrect tips.

However, SSF's strong request is that all participants in this summer's competitions try to use correct and approved pole tips. During the summer of 2023, the regulations will apply in full and athletes with incorrect tips will not be allowed to start.
