






Finish



- All athletes leave the timing chips and BIBs at finish after their qualification race
- Results on computer in tent (at finish and Athlets tent at start)
- New BIBs and timing chips are picked up before quarter finals
- Eliminated athletes during the finals leave the timing chips and skies at pick up location (close to athlets tent at start)
- All athletes stay for prize giving ceremony, keep the BIB on

BACK TO ATHLETE ZONE





Return to the Athlete zone via minibuses as shuttles (to Alberts hotel and then a short walk down the stairs).

It is possible to go with roller skies but the roads are open to public and traffic.

Athlete who are qualified for the next final shall return with priority to the start via the Athlete zone

Special focus between the semifinals and finals, since the time between them is relatively short!

NEW ICR 2022



Pole-tips

SSF wants to make all participants aware that new rules regarding pole tips will come into force during the summer.

Pole-tips must be designed as follows:

"396.2.6 Cross-Country ski poles must be used with Cross-Country skiing tips must be used. Alternatively poles tips must have safety rigid plastic protections with diameter ≥30 mm. These protections must be placed maximum 45 mm above the metallic tips. The rule will be implemented from 01st July 2022."

As these pole tips can currently be difficult to buy, SSF has decided that at competitions arranged in Sweden during the summer of 2022, only check and test measure tips. Athletes who participate in these competitions will not be banned from starting due to incorrect tips.

However, SSF's strong request is that all participants in this summer's competitions try to use correct and approved pole tips. During the summer of 2023, the regulations will apply in full and athletes with incorrect tips will not be allowed to start.
