





Course - Continued



All athletes leave the transponders and BIBs at finish after their qualification race. **Skis shall be returned at the Ski tent after qualification**

Results on computer in tent (at finish and Athlets tent at start) as well as on live.skidor.com and FIS live

New BIBs and transponders are picked up in the BIB's tent before quarter finals. New skis at ski hand out.

Eliminated athletes during the finals leave the transponders and skis at pick up location (close to athlets tent at start)

Athletes stay for prize giving ceremony, keep the BIB on. The prize ceremony are at the scene at the start area.

Back to Athlete zone



Return to the Athlete zone via minibuses as shuttles (to Alberts hotel and then a short walk down the stairs).

It is possible to go with rollerskies but the roads are open to public and traffic.

Athlete who are qualified for the next final shall return with priority to the start via the Athlete zone

Special focus between the semifinals and finals, since the time between them is relatively short!

It is NOT allowed to go on the roller skis down Landbergsliden (last uphill)!

- •Athletes responsibilites ICR 343:
- •Obstruction-ICR 343.9 and 343.10
- •Please follow organiser's instructions-ICR 343.3
- •Ski hand out and ski delivering
- •Ski in the competition course direction also during training! ICR 343.2
- Equipment ICR 396.2
- •Poles tips with diameter ≥30 mm, maximum45 mm above the metallictips-ICR 396.2.6
- •Safety helmets and eye protection must be worn during official training and competition-ICR 396.2.7
- Protest
- •Only accepted on the final heats ICR 325.6.2
