

#### **Course – Before Start**

BIBs and transponder distribution in the BIB-tent to the left when entering the arena. BIB pick up Juniors from 07:00 BIB pick up Seniors from 11:00

Roller skies (SWENOR Alutech with wheel type 3) are provided by Alliansloppet for all elite participants:

- Juniors
   Women BIB 501-540
   Men BIB 1-130
   to pick up skis at LL/SWENOR
- The rest to pick up skis at Rullskidcenter

The skis shall be picked up by each competitor on the way to the start.

Skis hand out from:

07:45 Juniors 11:15 WOMEN

11:45 MEN

BIB should be presented when picking up the skis! The skis are returned directly after finish at the same place!

# Course - Unique finish Lap 3 for Senior Men Elite

Unique course before the finish for the front group of 'Men Elit 48 km', on the road all the way from Båberg instead of the parallel bicycle road after NÄL roundabout. The road will be closed and cleared from traffic. Front group of MEN Elite MUST use the right hand side of the road all the way to the finish on LAP 3. It is NOT allowed to use the cycle path / pavement.

All the rest of "Men Elite", "Women Elit" and "Juniors" will use the same course for all three laps (on parallel bicycle-road).

# **GPS transponders**

Some athletes will have GPS transponders. The GPS-transponders will be packed with the BIB envelope.

#### **Pole support Bicycle**

Two neutral pole service bikes will follow the first groups in both Senior Women and Senior Men.

One of the bikes will follow a break-out leader.

Raise the arm to notify, and fall back to the bicycle

Right-poles on left side of the bicycle, left-poles on right side of the bicycle

The pole support bicycle can't take care of the broken pole!

#### **Broken poles**

Three pole support stations

- Landbergsliden
- Båberg
- Alliansloppet Arena

Replacement poles from the pole support bikes and/or the pole stations to be returned in the BIB tent

Broken poles, left at the pole support stations, will be possible to pick up in the BIB tent during the day

Båberg and the Arena will also have extra roller skis.





















## **Safety**

- Follow Police and Alliansloppet officials' directives
- Ordinary traffic rules apply and the roads are NOT closed!
- Roundabouts MUST be passed on the right hand side!
- Sidewalks in first hill and in Båberg are NOT allowed to be used!
- Official motorcycles from Alliansloppet will clear the road!

## Safety - Coach zone

- Support crew are NOT permitted to follow skiers along the race track during the race!
- Coaching shall be done from the marked side of the road
- Coaches shall be on site at coach zone before start of the race.
- All travel shall be done in the direction of the course and with respect to other competitors.

#### **Information form TD**

- Athletes responsibilities ICR 343:
  - Obstruction ICR 343.9
  - Classic Technique ICR 343.8 Turning technique zones are marked
- Equipment ICR 396.2
  - Poles tips with diameter ≥30 mm, maximum 45 mm above the metallic tips ICR 396.2.6 (Not permitted to start without correct tip)
  - Safety helmets and eye protection is mandatory- ICR 396.2.7
- Coaching zones
  - Coaching, feeding and pole service according to ICR 344.2
- Garbage/bottles shall be picked up at feeding stations!
